Tony provided a brief overview of a few of the board member positions responsibility/role:  
Player Agent (Bill Euker) is responsible for player evaluations, player selection, and All Stars.

Registration position will obtain the player sheets and form teams in the SI app. An extract of the teams will be sent to the Uniform Manager to organize jerseys/uniforms.

Development Manager is responsible for organizing clinics that are ran through the league.

#### OPENING DAY:

Opening Day is currently scheduled for April 10. Ashley suggested to scale it down from the usual events due to the uncertainty with COVID-19 and how it will be at that time. Bringing in Food trucks for the day was suggested. Kids will be required to spread out during the event.

Tony suggested Ashley reach out to the township to confirm opening day activities are allowed.

#### REGISTRATION UPDATE/2021 LEAGUE DATES:

Registration is currently open and will end on February 20.

March 12-15 – CVLL Dicks Shop Days, this year it will be offered in store and on-line.

There are currently 92 players registered – 16 majors; 32 minors; 24 ponys; 18 teeball; 2 13 yr olds.

Total registration is usually close to 300 players, including teenagers which is usually 25 players. Hopefully, we will be close to that number this year. However, given the current situation with the COVID-19 pandemic, the number of total players is uncertain.

OTHER:

Scoreboard installed at Stony Ridge Field 5 last fall season.

Uniforms are prepaid due to the last spring season being canceled. The front of the jerseys has been done – player number and sponsor need done yet.

Currently, there is approximately \$7,800 credits on players accounts from last spring ball season (COVID-19) cancellation. It is unclear what the financials will be after registration since the number of players registered is down and the uniforms have already been paid for.

Lights at Monroe Founders Field: Quote received for \$92,000 plus additional \$48,000 for installation.

Tony recently applied for and submitted a grant request from a local trust fund for \$20,000.

Golf outings – Tyler indicated the first-year goal for the golf outing fundraiser - \$20,000 and moving forward could potentially be much higher. Currently, there are six individuals who are on the list to help out with the golf outing. CVLL will be reaching out for any others who are interested in helping the outing.

Consignment of used baseball gear – Ashley asked if there was anything scheduled through CVLL as a consignment of used baseball gear. A suggestion was made to make a facebook thread/post on CVLL's facebook page of "For Sale or ISO" items.

Sponsorships – Dave has reached out to several businesses with no results yet. It was also noted to keep in mind that a couple of fields at Stony Ridge are in need of a sponsor.

Equipment – CVLL is in a fairly good position with equipment. As such, the \$750 Dicks dollars will go towards game balls.
